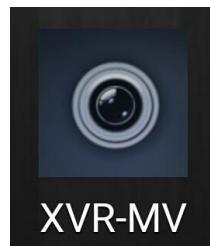


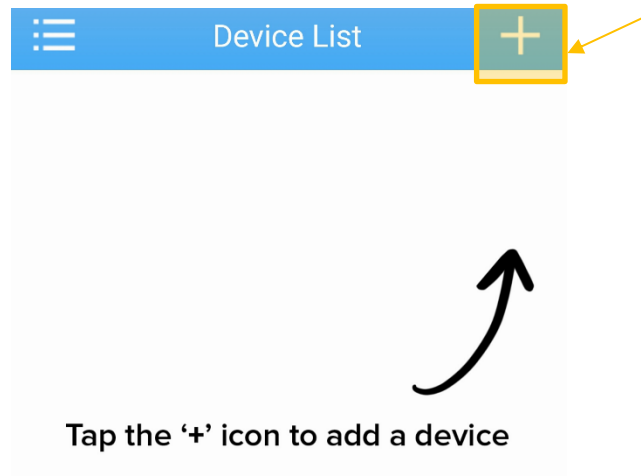
XVR-MV APP QUICKSTART GUIDE

The XVR-MV application is a quick and easy option in allowing you access to your DVR when away or local to your unit. Below is a quick walkthrough on the steps to adding your DVR to the application.


First step in setting up your XVR-MV application is to simply open the application.



Once open you will then select the plus icon located in the top right corner of the app to add your device.



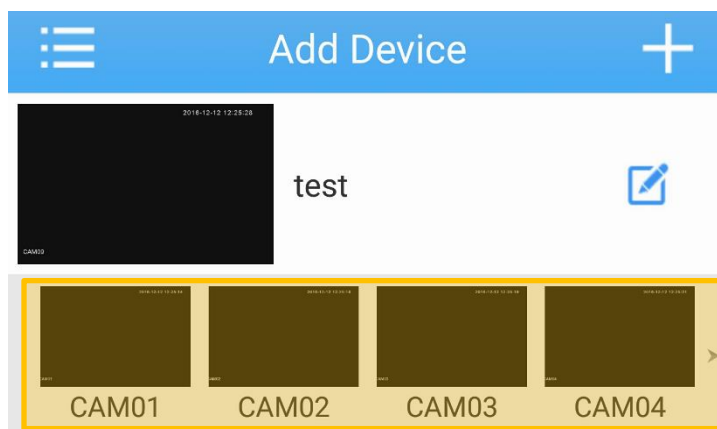
Selecting the plus sign will pull up the Add Device section. Here you will fill in all of the corresponding information matching your DVR. Below is a brief description of what needs to be input in each field. Once all fields are filled in select **OK to save**.

- Device Name**: Here you will input what you'd like your NVR to be called within the app.
- IP/Domain Name**: Here you will input the IP address of your unit. When local to the unit you will use the DVR's IP address, when remote you will use the public IP address of the location the DVR's installed.
- Port**: Here you will input the Media Port set on your DVR. (By default this port will be set to 34567.)
- Username**: Here you will input your username (This will be the same as what's used locally on the NVR itself)
- Password**: Here you will input your password. (This will be the same as what's used locally on the DVR itself)
- Advanced**: A checkbox that is currently checked.
- OK**: A button to save the device.
- Cancel**: A button to cancel the device addition.
- Search**: A button for auto search. Auto Search is a quick option to add any DVR's within the network your phone is connected to.

Once saved, the unit will be added to the device list. To livestream a camera, simply select whichever channel number you'd like from the list beneath the name given to your device.



Once a camera is selected, the app will pull that camera's livestream in a single view screen. To livestream multiple cameras at the same time simply slide through the toolbar at the bottom of the app until you see the four different window split options. Here you can select which view you wish to utilize.
