BASIC OPERATIONS

The User Manual introduces the operations of AztechRaptorVue App, and some functions might associate with the operations on the device, in these cases, please refer to the Easy Start Guide that comes with the device.

SIGNING UP / LOGGING IN

<u>Step 1</u>

Connect your smartphone to your wireless router.

<u>Step 2</u>

Download the **AztechRaptorVue** app from Google Play or App Store on your phone.




<u>Step 3</u>

Install and launch the app. Tap **Sign up** to create a new account.



<u>Step 4</u>

Enter your email address, set your password, and tap Verification code.




<u>Step 5</u>

ADDING A CAMERA VIA WIFI


<u>Step 1</u>

Tap the (+) icon in the middle, or on the top right of the screen to add a new camera.




<u>Step 2</u>

<u>Step 3</u>


Enter the WiFi password of your wireless router and tap Next.



<u>Step 4</u>


Turn up the volume of your smartphone and point its speaker to the microphone of the camera.

Wait until the camera connects to the wireless router.




<u>Step 5</u>

<u>Step 6</u>


Once the camera is successfully added, change the time zone to the country you set up the Aztech RaptorVue camera in, and tap **Complete**.

ADDING A CAMERA VIA WIRED CONNECTION

Use the network cable to connect the device and the router, meanwhile, connect your smartphone to the same router wirelessly.






LIVE VIEW

The live view provides real-time video display in normal display mode and landscape display mode. You can perform operations such as pause, window splitting, and mute. The zooming operation by gesture (pinch out to zoom in or pinch in to zoom out) is completed through digital zoom.



Live view (normal display mode)









MANAGING DEVICE

You can configure the settings for the added IP camera such as recording schedule, time zone, and alarms.

To enter the device management interface, tap **My Device** on the **My Account** tap, and then tap the device name.


The **Device Info** interface shows the functions that you can configure on the device. The actual interface might be different depending on the device you added.

PARAMETER	FUNCTION		
Device Name	Displays device information such as device name, model name, and SN. You can also reset device password from here.		
Smart Tracking	If the Smart Tracking function is enabled, when there is an object appears, the camera automatically follows its moving track till it is out of the view.		
Activity Zones	You can define a motion detection area. When the object appears in this area, the system activates alarm.		
Alarm Information	Enables the alarm activation function, such as motion detection, local alarm, and PIR alarm.		
General Record Schedule	You can configure the schedule for recording video.		
Storage Status	You can view the storage status of cloud storage and device SD card storage.		
Customize Video Encryption	If the Customize Video Encryption function is enabled, you can set a password for viewing the videos that are stored in the Cloud. When you log in to AztechRaptorVue App from other smartphones, you should enter this password for the first time to access the live view interface.		
Time Zone	You can configure the time zone and enable DST for the device.		
Rotate Image	Enables the image rotate function.		
Device Indicator	Enables the LED indicator at the back of the camera.		
Device Sharing	You can share the added devices to other AztechRaptorVue App users.		
Cloud Update	Indicates if there is an updated version.		
Wi-Fi Config	You can configure the Wi-Fi connection settings from here.		
Delete Device	Tap Delete Device to delete the device from your AztechRaptorVue App.		

MANAGING NOTIFICATIONS

You can read the personal alerts, system notifications, and view the recorded videos on the **Notice** interface.



Personal Alert

A reserved area for notification that relates to your account, such as cloud storage expire notification, or device share notification. Please note the incoming App update.

• System Info

View the notifications that are pushed from server.

Recorded video

Tap the video to enter the calendar interface. Tap the date that you want to view the recorded videos, and tap the specific file to view the recorded video.

PARAMETER	FUNCTION
My Cloud	View the orders of Cloud storage plan such as unpaid order, paid order, and cancelled order.
My Device	Enters the device information interface.
Downloads	Displays the videos that are in the process of downloading.
Local Files	 You can view the recorded videos or snapshots. For iOS smartphone, you can share the local files with other apps, download to your smartphone, or delete the files. For Android smartphone, you can only share the local files with other apps or delete the files.
Settings	You can change account password, set motion detection period, reset device password, view the version information and FAQ, provide feedback, join the user experience plan, clear cache, and exit the current account.

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
